

## **Combined Parish Pastoral Council, Meeting June 21, 2016 held at 6:30pm at St. Alphonsus**

### **Minutes:**

Rich Weber called the meeting to order at 6:35pm. Those in attendance were: Fr. Terry Langley, Elaine Burke, Mary Ehr, Linda Kron, Bonnie Mayer, Doug Schomberg, Bernie Schyvinck, Mark Seegers, Brian Sekey, Greg Sim, Rich Weber and Pat Vos. New member Mary Gronke was also present. Absent: Mark Kashik, Naoma Livingston, Darlene Roanhaus, Vicki Skinner, and Mary Meyers.

Opening Prayer was led by Bernie Schyvinck. Prayers were requested for Sue Jozapaitis who is ill. Minutes were approved.

Synod implementation: In September Mark Kemmeter will meet with the group to review where we are with our goals. Review of the 1 year and 3 year plan will take place. Finance, Prayer & Worship and committees involved with those goal will be notified that reports will be needed from them.

New Business: A selection of officers took place. Discussion on who would take positions. Brian Sekey agreed to be Chair with the understanding that there will be times he is absent due to work responsibilities. It was suggested that Darlene Roanhaus take on the Vice-Chair and Vicki stay as secretary. This will be reviewed at the next meeting when the liaisons for our other committees are selected. It was also questioned as to the term of those being requested to attend the Finance Council meetings. What is the length of their term? (Linda Kron will no longer be a part of the PPC, so her presence on the Finance will need to be replaced.) Naomi and Bonnie are Finance representatives for St. John; do they stay on Finance for St. John or does another member take their place?

From the Floor: 1.) St. Alphonsus proxy for the tuck-pointing has been approved. 2.) Bonnie mentioned that a decision on the Mission Statement and the background for the signs need to be determined. 3.) Mary Gronke brought up that a dance will be held on Saturday, July 16<sup>th</sup> at St. John, they will hold one in August and in September and then decide if to continue during months ahead. 4.) KOC has invited the two parishes to join them and share profits for their Breakfast to be held on Sunday, July 24<sup>th</sup>. Volunteers from the parishes are requested. This is during the Country Thunder weekend and the Knights are anticipating a large turn-out. 5.) The Aquanauts of Twin Lakes have invited us to share profits of their free-will collection on the night of June 29<sup>th</sup>. Attendance by the parish members is encouraged at their event that night. 6.) It was brought up that the stone on the corner of the circle drive at St. John was run over the prior weekend. This apparently has happened several times. It has been suggested that flasher posts be placed around the stone. 7.) Linda Kron expressed her thanks to the PPC during her term on the committee. Linda has served for a full-term of 6 years. 8.) The committee thanked Rich Weber for his terms of service on the PPC also. 9.) St. John elevator project was brought up and discussed. This is going forward. Jude Tindall and Kevin Fitzgerald are heading the committee with a group of 6 to 7 others. 10.) A Stewardship Ministry Fair is hoped to be planned for September or early October. Interested parties are to meet yet.
